IN GREECE DURING 2012

**INSTRUCTIONS AND NOTES FOR APPLICANTS**

Applications should be typewritten, and three copies must be submitted. Each of the numbered categories below must be included in the application and must have a corresponding number. Applications must not exceed ten pages. **The scholarship must be taken up during 2012.**

- 1. Full name of the applicant**
- 2. Name of the scholarship** for which the application is submitted
- 3. Date of the application**
- 4. Present address and telephone number(s) of the applicant**
- 5. Institution with which the applicant is affiliated, if applicable,** and the nature of that affiliation eg, Honours student, MA candidate, PhD candidate, tutor, lecturer etc.
- 6. Date and place of birth, citizenship or Australian residence status**
- 7. Educational history**

A list in chronological order of the institutions of higher learning attended by the applicant is required. Dates of attendance, as well as certificates, diplomas degrees etc must be listed. If the applicant is a candidate for a degree, the name of that degree, the institution and the expected date of completion should be provided. Official transcripts of the applicant's academic record must be enclosed.
- 8. Proposed date and place of departure for Greece**
- 9. Thesis or dissertation**

If the proposed research is directly related to a thesis or dissertation, the applicant should describe that relationship, and comment on the possibilities of publication.

**10. Experience**

Any experience in teaching, research, archaeological fieldwork etc., related to the purpose of this application should be mentioned. In the case of employment, the name and address of the employer and the applicant's position and duties should be included.

**11. Languages**

Any experience of foreign languages, ancient or modern, useful for the applicant's research, and the standard achieved in each, should be included.

**12. Financial resources**

The applicant should list any other applications for financial support made in connection with the proposed research.

**13. References**

The names and addresses of three referees should be provided. The applicant should request the referees to write directly to the Selection Committee at the following address; letters should be clearly marked IN CONFIDENCE:

If the applicant's research proposal is related to a dissertation, a recommendation from the Supervisor is required.

**14. Full title and description of the proposed research programme**

A full description of the proposed research, including any associated travel within or outside Greece, is required; this should include the proposed programme itself and a draft budget.

**15. Undertaking to submit a report**

The applicant must undertake to submit, at the end of the research programme, a written report providing a detailed account of the activities conducted during tenure of the scholarship. The scholarship-holder is expected, on returning, to give a talk to the ANU (Canberra) Friends of the AAIA on material related to the research undertaken.

**16. Photograph**

A passport photograph must accompany **each copy** of the application.

**17. Closing date for applications**

The three letters of reference, health certificate and any supporting material, and three copies of the application must be in the hands of the Chair of the Selection Committee **no later than 15 October 2011**.
